



THE BTRDA FOREST RALLY CHAMPIONSHIPS HAVE SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE IN 2010

The **Silverstone Tyres BTRDA Gold Star® Championship** is open to all competitors competing in rally cars over 1400cc, with 7 championship classes plus a very competitive Production Cup and Clubmans Production Cup for earlier model Gp N4 cars. The **Silverstone Tyres BTRDA Silver Star® Championship** is exclusively for competitors in 2 wheel drive cars over 1400cc.

Now in their 57th consecutive year, the BTRDA Gold Star & Silver Star Championships have consistently proved the most popular rally championships in the UK.

The **Millers Oils BTRDA 1400 Rally Championship**, now in its 10th year, provides a competitive environment for cars up to 1400cc, split into 3 championship classes and running in advance of the main field on all events. Millers Oils support is shared by all the drivers who each receive a £50 Millers Oils voucher at their 1st event and a further £50 voucher at their 4th event. In addition, all drivers in the Millers Oils BTRDA 1400 Championship will be eligible to receive £20 Finishers awards so a consistent driver can earn up to £140 during the season. A special prize on offer to one of the Millers Oils 1400 Championship crews will be a trip for two people to the 2011 Malaysian GP as the guests of Silverstone Tyres and Service & Sport.

The inaugural year of the **MG ZR Rally Challenge**, which is open to any MG ZR up to 1400cc was very popular with competitors, and this is set to continue in 2010

The Gold Star, Silver Star, Millers 1400's and the MG ZR's are all based around on a calendar of 8 classic Nat B forest rallies using some of the best stages in the UK (best 6 scores to count).

All the championship events are aiming to achieve a standard entry fee of £400 or less in 2010. Championship registration fees have also been reduced.

BTRDA® Rally First has been one of the recent successes of the Silverstone Tyres BTRDA® Rally Series and this is set to develop further in 2010. In addition to the existing RF1.4 class, the BTRDA and F1000 Rally Club are working together to promote the F1000 Forest Championship which will run under the BTRDA Rally First umbrella with all competitors eligible for the benefits of both the F1000 Rally Club and BTRDA Rally First including the £50 reduction in entry fees and the £20 finishers awards. The awards list has been extended and new Junior Driver and Junior Co-driver awards added to recognise the performance of competitors aged 23 or under.

The **MSA English Rally Championship** will expand in 2009 with the addition of an extra event a new championship class and some junior awards. The Championship is open to all 2 wheel drive cars up to 2 litres and retains its class based format so that competitors from any class have an equal chance of winning the overall championship titles.
