

RALLY CHAMPIONS & AWARD WINNERS 2003

The Dee Jays Cambrian Rally saw an exciting climax to the 2003 season where two of the three Rally Championships were finally decided.

The exception was the **Dunlop Gold Star Championship**, the most prestigious title in club rallying, which had already been claimed on the Plains Rally by **Andy Burton & Rob Morgan** who won six events during the year and thus scored maximum points; a feat never before accomplished. They become the first crew in recent years to have won both the Silver Star [1995 & 2000] and the Gold Star titles. The runners up for the Gold Star title were Brian Bell & Paul Spooner followed by Martin Healer & Peter Thomas.

Once again the **DUNLOP Silver Star Champion** driver is **Jon Ballinger** but not without the most nail biting of finishes. Going into the last round there were 4 crews that could win the title and at the end Jon and **Jason Lepley** had equal points and were only split by the second tie decider. Jason's co-driver **Simon Sparey** claims the Silver Star Co-drivers title by margin of one point. The Silver Star championship continues to be the place for two-wheel drive rally competition in the UK with more than 35 cars starting every round of the championship.

The **Silkolene 1400 Championship** has provided a closely fought battle on every event during the season with a number of crews in with a good chance of claiming the title. However in the end it came down to a contest between **Gary Standen** and **Shaun Woffinden** on the last event where Shaun, accompanied by **Howard Pridmore**, scored the maximum points they needed to take the title by just one point.
