You should have received your BTRDA membership card, or if you have recently registered it will be with you shortly. Don't worry if it hasn't arrived in time for the Cambrian Rally (17th February) as the BTRDA Membership Secretary, Paul Price, will be at the event and will be able to confirm your membership.

For those competitors who have not yet registered for 2018 then you can do so via the on-line BTRDA membership registration system www.btrdamembership.com or print off a Registration form from the championship website www.btrdarally.com/competitors/ and send it to Paul Price, the Membership Secretary. If all else fails, you can register at the BTRDA desk at any of the championship events. (Registrations close after the Nicky Grist Stages).

The membership card carries your BTRDA Club membership number and your BTRDA Championship registration number (drivers start with a 7 and co-drivers with a 2). Your registration also includes eligibility for the *MAXXIS* MSA English Rally Championship which starts on the Malcolm Wilson Stages.

The 2018 Jordan Road Surfacing BTRDA Rally Series calendar includes 8 very popular one-day forest events and we are pleased to include a new event to the Championship, the Rallynuts Stages to be based in Mid Wales. Your final championship results will be based on your **best 6 scores**.

CHAMPIONSHIP DECALS

Championship decals will be posted out from 28th January to all drivers who are registered for the 2018 Championship, <u>up to the 7th February</u> so you should receive them in time to put them on before the Cambrian Rally. These decals (1 x screen strip and 2 x sponsor panels- 375mm x 265mm; one for each side of the car) must be displayed on the rally car to qualify for Championship points and also to identify the car so you can appear on the TV programmes. Those not registered by 7th February can collect them from the signing on desk of your first event in the BTRDA series.

CHANGES FOR THE 2018 CHAMPIONSHIP

As well as the inclusion of a new event to replace the Somerset Stages, we have made a few changes to our class structure and introduced a new category:

- The new Rallye R2 Cup exclusively for R2 cars
- Re-structure of the Historic Classes to include the increasingly popular Cat 4a and b cars.
- Inclusion of new 2.0L Rally First Class

CAMBRIAN RALLY – 17th FEBRUARY

The Cambrian rally will once again start the championship season off in Llandudno. This year's route offers a change in format. The very compact route stays completely within the Conwy County on maps 115 & 116 and offers some 45 miles of challenging stages along with a new central service area at Surf Snowdonia. North Wales Car Club have already received a strong entry so if you have not yet entered the event then you should do so as soon as possible at www.cambrianrally.co.uk It will certainly provide some Serious Fun and let's all hope for better weather this year!

CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY PRE AND POST EVENT SCRUTINEERING

It is an important part of any Championship to ensure competing cars meet their eligibility requirements as set down in the Championship regulations and the MSA Yearbook (Blue Book). At the end of every event cars will be selected for post event Scrutineering by the Championship Eligibility Scrutineers. You should not be concerned if you are asked to attend such checks as we would much prefer to confirm your car is correct than find a problem. If you have any doubts about eligibility, please contact the Championship Eligibility Scrutineers. For any FIA homologated cars, especially classes NR4 or N3, please remember to carry an original set (not a copy) of the relevant homologation forms in the car at all times. By not carrying them or having incorrect ones, you risk not scoring any championship points on that event. Simple, but often forgotten.

BTRDA RALLY FIRST

All BTRDA Rally First cars are required to submit a Vehicle Declaration Form (VDF) to any of the on-event BTRDA team or the Championship Scrutineers. This form and the BTRDA Rally First Technical Regulations are available under the Competitors section of the BTRDA Rally website.

ON EVENT FUEL / RE-FUEL

As in 2017 Vital Equipment will be the official fuel supplier to the BTRDA Rally Series and will be at all the events. MALCOLM WILSON RALLY – 3rd MARCH

Entries are now available for the Malcolm Wilson Rally, Round 2 of the BTRDA Rally Series and Round 1 of the MSA English Championship. Regulations and online entries can be found at www.malcolmwilson.co.uk The event includes iconic stages such as Grizedale North and South and Greystoke. The event is based in the friendly town of Cockermouth where scrutineering will take place on the Main Street & documentation. The event will again start in the nearby M-Sport complex and the finish will be, as last year, within a few metres of Junction 40 of the M6. So get your entries in quickly for this great event.

MAXXIS MSA ENGLISH RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP

For the **2018** *MAXXIS* **MSA English Rally Championship** we have reverted back to an all gravel format but as last year will be open to **all** cars that comply with the MSA Safety and Technical Regulations. The 2018 Championship will include a selection of the best one day forest events in England, with the addition of a one Welsh event, the Nicky Grist Stages. A total of six events make up the Championship with the final round being the Wyedean Stages in the Forest of Dean in November. The best five scores will count.

The Championship will be split into 8 championship classes with the scoring system reflecting achievement against other competitors in the same class as in 2017.

- Class 6 Current and former FIA Group N / NR4 cars over 2000cc
- Class 7 Over 2000cc 4 Wheel Drive
- Class 8 All WRC, RRC, R5 and S2000 cars and all derivatives
