EVENTSIGNS WOODPECKER STAGES

MRF TYRES BTRDA GOLD STAR® CHAMPIONSHIP

PEARSON HITS DOUBLE TOP TO FINISH AHEAD!...

In his first full season of MRF Tyres BTRDA Rally Series events, Garry Pearson followed up his maximum Gold Star® Championship points score on the Scottish Rally with outright victory on the Eventsigns Woodpecker Stages and, obviously, credited his account with another 30 in the process! Pearson and Niall Burns set fastest – equal fastest on one occasion - times on all five stages in their Fabia and, after 44 miles of competition in the Radnor forest complex, arrived at the finish 58s ahead of the flying Lancer EVOX of George Lepley/Tom Woodburn.

lan Bainbridge/Will Atkins, in another Fabia, were 3rd, ahead of Gold Star leaders prior to the Woodpecker, Elliot Payne/Cameron Fair (Fiesta). Although no strangers to the BTRDA Series, Perry Gardener/Jack Bowen were making their debut in a Fiesta R5 and, featuring in the Top Ten on four of the five stages, came home in a very creditable 5th place, just four seconds in front of 2016 Gold Star Champions Charlie Payne/Carl Williamson (Fiesta WRC).

So, with three rounds gone and (all being well!) three to go, Pearson leads the Gold Star drivers' table by one point from Payne Jnr. who, in turn, is a similar margin ahead of Lepley. Meanwhile, Fair holds sway in the race for the Co-drivers' title but he has both Burns and Woodburn breathing down his neck, one and two points respectively adrift.

After a double puncture caused them to throw in the towel last time out in Scotland, Callum Black/Jack Morton were looking to the Woodpecker for an opportunity to get their season back on track. Lying 2nd after three stages, their Fiesta came off second-best in an altercation with some logs on SS4 and, unfortunately for the pair, a second consecutive DNF ensued. Never fear! The regulations state that, from a six-round Series, everyone's four best scores will count — so, there's still time to turn things around!...

Lepley/Woodburn's fine run served to consolidate their lead in B13, but Ian Joel/Graeme Wood's 7th in their Escort Cosworth, exactly half-a-minute and two places in front of Richard Hill's Lancer, keep both in with a shout of the class title. Or, to put it another way, Lepley/Woodburn now have three goes to get the one

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maximum they need to put the matter beyond doubt. Gentlemen, start your engines!.....

Pat Naylor/lan Lawrence's Group N Lancer EVO9 finished unchallenged, between Joel & Hill, to give the Midlanders their second maximum BTRDA Production Cup score.

So, Filey and the North York Moors are next on the agenda for the Trackrod Forest Rally - some of the quickest stages of the season and, with things so tight at the top, it'll be an interesting day for all concerned!...

The top points scorer in both the MRF Tyres BTRDA Silver Star® Championship and the Jordan Road Surfacing BTRDA Historic Cup® bears a surname that will be very familiar to seasoned Woodpecker watchers. Robert Gough is the son of five-times Woodpecker winner Richard and it's guite obvious that speed is in the genes

- or should that be 'racing overalls'?... Anyway, an outing on the Nicky Grist Stages ended prematurely but, this time, it all went to plan and Robert and his Escort are now firmly ensconced in the points tables for both the above series.

Ioan Lloyd/Sion Williams brought their Peugeot 208R2 home a handful of seconds behind Gough, with Owen McMackin's Escort claiming third-place points. Gough Snr's ex- Rothmans Escort was next with co-driver Jonny Tad Evans' efforts rewarded with plenty of Silver Star & Historic Cup points. Following a non-finish in Scotland, 2017 Silver Star Champion Ashley Davies and co-driver Sam Fordham's Escort was back in the points and, in spite of spending more than half-a-minute in a ditch on SS4, just managed to hold off Rob Wright/Mark Fisher's similar car by the slender margin of 7s!

Notwithstanding the frantic activity being played out ahead of them, Paul Street/Ian Jones (Escort) and Baz Jordan/Arwel Jenkins (Avenger) both kept their 100% finishing records so far this season intact and their consistency sees them retaining their 1st & 2nd places respectively in both Silver Star and Historic Cup. Martin Freestone (Escort) and Tom Coughtrie/Ian Fraser (Mitsubishi Galant VR4) both recorded their third consecutive finishes of the season, not only maintaining their 3rd & 4th places in the Cup, but also keeping them in touching distance of the leaders.

BTRDA RALLYE R2/JUNIOR R2 CUP

R2 DETOUR...

Following the huge success of the BTRDA Rallye R2 Cup over the past few seasons, we were naturally disappointed by the slow start to both the R2 and R2 Junior Cups in 2021. This, in turn, has led to an enforced

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review of the list of end-of-season awards (don't worry we're working on it!), but interest continues to increase and we currently have ten drivers on the books. From them, Jonathan Jones is the only one to have maintained a clean sheet to date and his consistency is paying off handsomely as, at the halfway stage, he leads the R2 Cup in his Fiesta. However, the Bridgnorth driver needs to keep a wary eye out for Welshmen Ioan Lloyd/Sion Williams who, putting aside an off day (literally!) on the Scottish Rally, have dominated both R2 and Junior R2 Cups in their Peugeot 208.

As mentioned above, Lloyd/Williams were 2nd overall in the Silver Star battle on the Woodpecker and lead the R2 Junior Cup from Connor Tolson/Dylan Thomas (Fiesta) who opted to miss the Scottish but have been their nearest challengers on the other two occasions.

The Fiestas of Billy Grew and Sam Bilham entered the fray on the Woodpecker and, although both posted finishes, the latter was way down the order after losing six-and-a-half minutes on SS2.

FUCHS LUBRICANTS BTRDA 1400 CHAMPIONSHIP

A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE!...

Adrian & Matt Walk (Ford Ka) made history on the Woodpecker Stages when the father-and-son team became the first crew in a 1400C car to take maximum points in the Fuchs Lubricants BTRDA 1400 Championship. Indeed, the second-placed crew on the day were also in a 1400C car - Edward Wain/Noel Murphy's MG ZR finished ahead of the Escort of Aaron





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Rix/Abi Haycock who were the only scorers in Class 1400S.

As far as the fancied runners in the BTRDA Bronze Star were concerned, the phrase 'to finish first, you must first finish' will have a salutary ring to it as Richard Jordan/James Gratton-Smith (MG ZR), Steve Black/Paul Morris (Suzuki Swift) and Dave & Toby Brick (Vauxhall Nova) all retired on the first stage!... Jordan/Gratton-Smith will take some consolation from the fact that they still lead the table but, obviously, by a much reduced margin.

Tom Naylor (Fiesta ST) took his second maximum score in the MRF Tyres BTRDA Rally First Championship by finishing ahead of the MG ZR of Simon Double/Jessica Mitchell but, even so, there are only a couple of points between the two drivers at the top of the table. To be continued....

MOTORSPORT UK 2021 ENGLISH RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP IN ASSOCIATION WITH SEACON UK

AND THEN THERE WERE TWO!...

Following their opening encounter on the Nicky Grist Stages in July, contenders for the Motorsport UK 2021 English Rally Championship in association with Seacon UK had their second run-out on the Woodpecker Stages and, as predicted, the number of joint leaders in the class-based series has been significantly reduced. Prior to the start of the day, there were five drivers with maximum scores and now, following Round 2, it's left to George Lepley (Lancer EVOX) and Ioan Lloyd (Peugeot 208) to squabble over top spot. Their chance will come on the Trackrod Forest Stages at the end of September but of course, as everything is still very tight at the top,

there's no saying that others won't have joined them by then!

Outright Woodpecker winner Garry Pearson (Fabia) and Owen McMackin (Escort MkII) are 3rd=, two points adrift of the leaders, with Elliot Payne (Fiesta), Paul Street (Escort) and Jonathan Jones (Fiesta R2) another two points adrift. And so it goes on...

There are a maximum of 25 points available to each of the class winners and, with three events still remaining, you don't need an abacus to work out that there's plenty of scope for a change at the top before 2019 Champion Steve Black's successor is revealed...

FORTHCOMING EVENTS:

TRACKROD FOREST STAGES - SATURDAY 25th SEPTEMBER

This event will use all the traditional Yorkshire forests to provide a full 45 miles of single use stages. The Trackrod will again be based in Filey with Scrutineering and the Service Park at Filey Brigg Country Park. The Trackrod Forest Stages will start in Pickering with the Ceremonial Finish on Saturday afternoon on 'The Beach' at Filey. To enable BTRDA championship registered competitors on any of the three 'Trackrod' events to be eligible to score BTRDA Rally Series & English Rally Championship points, the allocation of championship points will be based on the cumulative times over the Saturday stages, provided that neither member of the crew have completed the pre-event recce.

VISIT CONWY CAMBRIAN RALLY - SATURDAY 30th OCTOBER

The penultimate rally in the 2021 MRF Tyres BTRDA Rally Series in the Visit Conwy Cambrian Rally. RALLYNUTS STAGES RALLY – SATURDAY 13th NOVEMBER

After postponing from April, the organisers of the Rallynuts Stages Rally are delighted to confirm that the event will run on 13th November 2021. Based in Builth Wells, the 44-mile gravel event will include classic stages in Myherin, Sweet Lamb and Hafren and will be the 6th and final round of the 2021 MRF Tyres BTRDA Rally Series.

Event regulations should be available on http://rallynutsrally.co.uk/ from 20th September with entries opening a few days later. Certainly, an event not to be missed.

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DECALS: Competitors are reminded that they **must** display the BTRDA Rally Series decals on each qualifying event to be eligible to score points in the MRF Tyres BTRDA Rally Series, MRF Mixed Surface Challenge and the Motorsport UK 2020 English Rally Challenge supported by SEACON UK. These include a **sponsor panel on each side of the car** and a **championship screen strip** which must be displayed on the windscreen, not on the roof. Checks will be carried out to ensure compliance with this! Decals went sent to registered drivers before the Nicky Grist Stages and are available from the BTRDA Co-ordinator Ian Arden Tel: 07917 355169 at each event.

Co-drivers with non-registered drivers must carry 2 x BTRDA club decals on the car.
